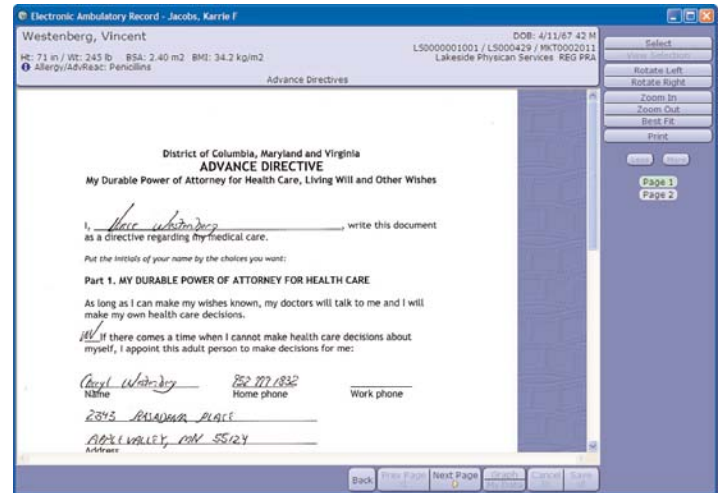


Health Maintenance and Disease Management

Processing External Documents

The Medical and Practice Management Suite includes the ability to scan paper documents as well as import electronic files. Scanning and importing components allow an organization to help maintain a completely paperless environment.

Features & Benefits

- Paper documents can be scanned directly into a patient's electronic record
- Electronic documents and picture files can be uploaded directly into a patient's electronic record
- Scanned and imported documents can be stored throughout the patient's electronic chart in specific sections, such as Laboratory, Imaging, Consent Forms, etc.
- External documents can be viewed by clinicians in the patient's MPM Patient Record
- External documents can be accessed on the back-end by office staff in order to view, enter, edit or delete documents
- An extensive audit trail is available identifying users who have accessed, added, edited and deleted external documents.
- Results from outside of the organization can be scanned in via a result entry routine accessible directly from the provider's desktop. These results can be linked to the appropriate Laboratory or Radiology panel.
- A variety of file types can be imported into the system and can be viewed using the default viewer for the file type
- External documents can be scanned or imported into patient records in black and white or color
