

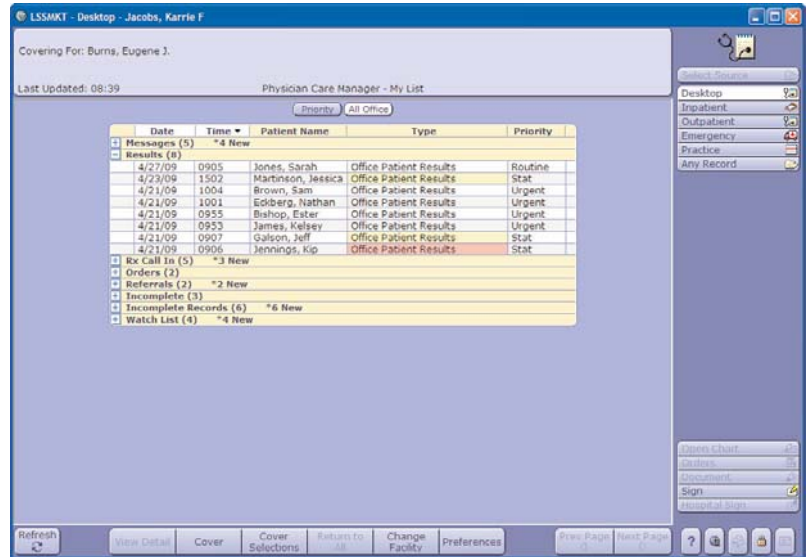
MPM Physician Desktop

The Physician Desktop is the primary point of access to a patient's health record, presenting an intuitive user interface to match a provider's workflow. Using one unique sign-on and password from any location (hospital, office, home or on the road) physicians may access their office schedules, manage their prioritized tasks, review lab and radiology results, process patient correspondence and electronically sign completed documentation and orders.

- Real-time notification of abnormal lab/radiology results
- Intra-office clinical messaging

- Real-time access to physician office schedules

Workload Management

The Physician Desktop has been designed to help physicians prioritize and streamline their daily workflow. The Workload Management tool utilizes "push technology" to notify the provider of critical test results and other items requiring immediate attention. Workload Management also allows physicians to effectively manage daily tasks, including:

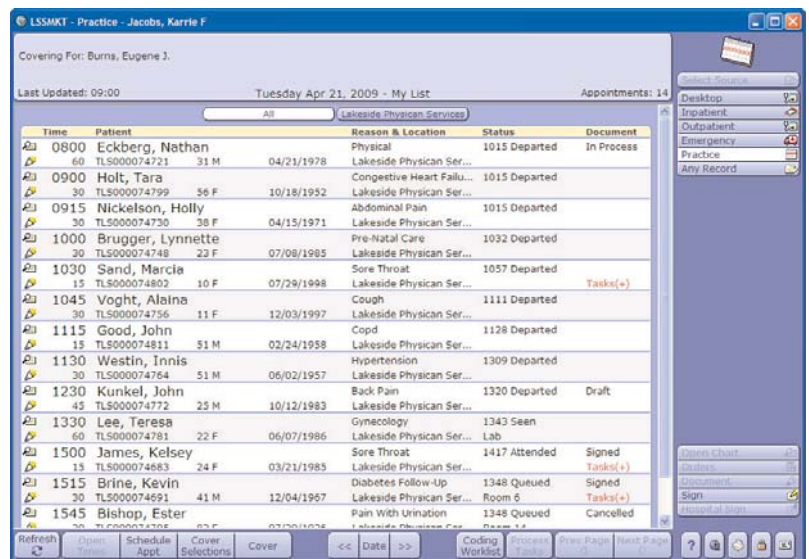
- Common screen to review and sign multiple medical records
- Task list to organize and prioritize prescription renewals, lab orders and results, clinical notes, etc.
- Concise, personalized physician schedule
- Direct access to the MPM Patient Record and MPM Ordering

Clinical Messaging

The Physician Desktop provides medical staff with a simple and intuitive tool for sending messages related to patient care. The messaging tool allows the user to prioritize and direct specific tasks, such as:

- Processing patient phone calls
- Reviewing diagnostic results flowing in real-time from MEDITECH's Laboratory and Radiology modules
- Notifying of overdue diagnostic orders
- Renewing prescriptions
- (Re)scheduling patient appointments

The messaging tool is fully integrated with the patient's MPM Patient Record. Therefore, each time a completed message is closed, a note is automatically attached to the patient's record.
